UNION COMPETENCES

Art 5 TEU new

1. The limits of Union competences are governed by the principle of conferral. The use of Union competences is governed by the principles of subsidiarity an proportionality.

FUNDAMENTAL RIGHTS

Art 6 TEU new

1. The Union recognises the rights, freedoms and principles set out in the Charter of Fundamental Rights of the European Union [...] which shall have the same legal value as the Treaties.

2. The Union shall accede to the European Convention for the Protection of Human Rights and Fundamental Freedoms. [...]

PROVISIONS ON DEMOCRATIC PRINCIPLES

[...]

Art 11 paragraph 4 TEU new:

Not less than one million citizens who are nationals of a significant number of Member States may take the initiative of inviting the European Commission, within the framework of its powers, to submit any appropriate proposal on matters where citizens consider that a legal act of the Union is required for the purpose of implementing the Treaties.
